## Qualifications

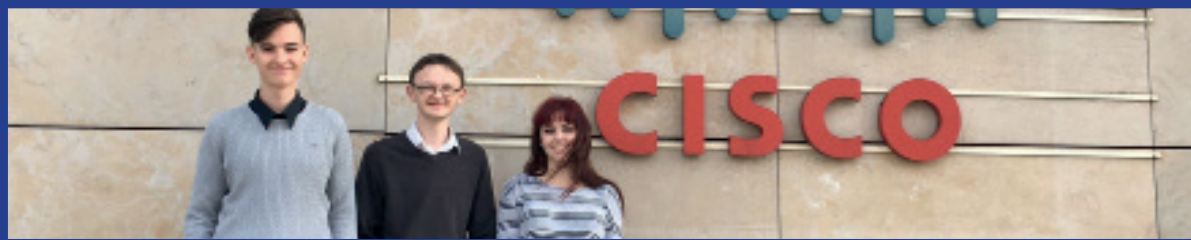
Our students study GCSEs, just like at other schools. However, they also get an opportunity to gain technical qualifications in our specialist areas of Computing and Building Studies.

## Employer-Led Education

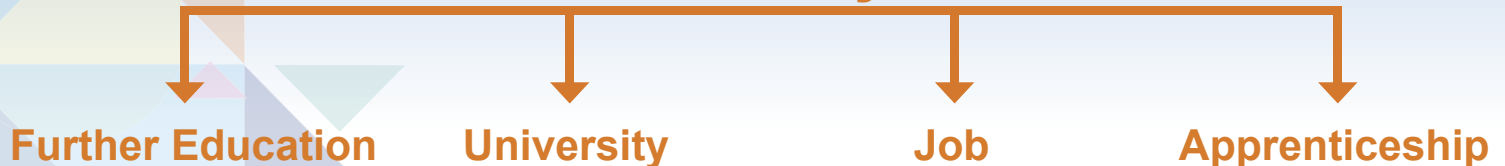
