



Request for Financial Support

It is possible that before your child is able to attend Bucks UTC, you may need help in overcoming financial difficulties that make it hard to afford the equipment or uniform for your course, or the cost of transport to the UTC by bus or train.

Bucks UTC Hardship Scheme

The Bucks UTC has an allocation of funds to help people attend Bucks UTC who may have difficulties with the costs of learning or travel. Funds are limited and awards are made on the basis of relative financial need, therefore applications are means tested.

If you have any financial difficulties, you may be able to apply for help under this Scheme.

Requests can be made at any time, but awards will not be back dated.

Bucks UTC has a Travel Support Scheme which will provide students with assistance towards termly bus passes or half termly train passes. You can apply for the scheme and any other support if the student:

- Is 14-18 years old
- Is enrolled full-time at Bucks UTC
- lives more than 3 miles away from Bucks UTC
- has a household income of less than £30,810pa

This support is dependent on 100% attendance by the student.

1. Proof of current income/proof of benefits e.g. Working Tax Credit (6 Page Document), Child Tax Credit **or** three consecutive pay slips and 3 consecutive bank statements for each working adult in the household
